Students demonstrated autonomy by limiting the number of project completeness questions. After triangulating the data, I concluded the study was effective. On the post-questionnaire, 72% reported the use of a rubric was helpful. The number of questions regarding project completeness was lower in comparison to the control group, and there was evidence to suggest students had a clearer understanding of how grades were earned.
